**Enfamil Infant**  
For ages birth to 12 months  
12.5 oz. powder  
13 oz. concentrate  
**Minimum Inventory**  
12 cans powder



**Enfamil Gentlease**  
For ages birth to 12 months  
12.4 oz. powder  
**Minimum Inventory**  
6 cans powder



**Similac Soy Isomil**  
For ages birth to 12 months  
12.4 oz. powder  
13 oz. concentrate  
**Minimum Inventory**  
6 cans powder



**Enfamil A.R.**  
For ages birth to 12 months  
12.9 oz. powder



**Enfamil Reguline**  
For ages birth to 12 months  
12.4 oz. powder

**Note for health care providers:** Medical documentation is not needed for infants under 12 months of age to receive a WIC contract formula. For children 12 months of age and older to receive a WIC contract formula, the Florida WIC Medical Documentation for Formula and Food form must be completed with a qualifying medical condition.
