

The Florida Department of Health is pleased to release the 2007 Florida Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) State and County Data Report. This historic surveillance effort would not have been possible without the support of Florida's 67 County Health Departments (CHDs).

The 2007 county-level BRFSS is the first since the initial county-level effort in 2002. The 2007 county-level survey was developed in collaboration with state and local representatives and better designed to meet the needs of CHD programs by offering options to add county-developed questions and increase sample sizes. In addition, 2007 county-level questionnaires included all of the questions asked on a state level, unlike 2002 in which an abbreviated questionnaire was administered.

Over 39,000 interviews were completed in the 2007 calendar year, with a target sample size of 500 completed surveys in each county. Three counties provided funding to increase overall sample sizes: Duval, Highlands, and Sarasota. Through funding from the Hispanic Obesity Prevention Education Program (HOPE), larger samples of Hispanic populations were possible in eight counties: Collier, DeSoto, Hardee, Hendry, Miami-Dade, Okeechobee, Orange, and Osceola. Five counties provided county-added questions: Clay, Collier, Duval, Monroe, and Orange.

The 2007 BRFSS provides counties and the state with a rich data source to estimate the prevalence of personal health behaviors that contribute to morbidity and mortality among adults in Florida. This report presents the survey data on a variety of issues related to health status, health care access, lifestyle, chronic illnesses, and disease prevention practice.

These data can be used to: (1) determine priority health issues and identify populations at highest risk for illness, disability, and death; (2) plan and evaluate prevention programs; (3) educate the community and policy makers about disease prevention; and (4) support community policies that promote health and prevent disease.

Because BRFSS respondents are randomly selected, measures of prevalence and mean are subject to random sample errors. Each measure listed in the data tables includes the 95% confidence interval (CI). Measures of prevalence and mean are excluded from the tables for any subpopulation with a sample size less than 30, which would yield statistically unreliable estimates. Available measures from the 2002 county-level survey are included for comparison purposes. Due to updated methods from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, some point estimates included in the 2002 BRFSS report may be slightly different than the 2002 measures in this report. The methods used to calculate the 2002 point estimates were updated to provide the best comparison between the two years. The significance of measures with very wide 95% confidence intervals should be interpreted with caution.

Pap Test	A cervical cancer screening test in which surface cells from the cervix are examined for cancer or pre-cancer characteristics.			
Poor Mental Health	Adults who report that their mental health, which includes stress, depression, and problems with emotions, was not good on 14 or more of the previous 30 days.			
Poor Physical Health	Adults who report that their physical health, which includes physical illness and injury, was not good on 14 or more of the previous 30 days.			
PSA Test	A Pro <mark>st</mark> ate-Specific Antigen test, also called a PSA test, is a blood test used to detect prostate cancer.			
Secondhand Smoke	Bein <mark>g ex</mark> posed to someone else's tobacco smoke in a room (at work or home) during th <mark>e past</mark> seven days.			
Sedentary	Engaging in no leisure-time physical activity.			
Sigmoidoscopy/Colonoscopy	Exams in which a tube is inserted in the rectum to view the colon for signs of cancer or other health problems.			
Vigorous Physical Activity	Engaging in vigorous activities, such as running, aerobics, heavy yard work, or anything else that causes large increases in breathing or heart rate for at least 20 minutes per day on three or more days per week.
