




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Thirty counties reported a total of 76 animal rabies cases as of October 31, 2014. Raccoons accounted for 41 / 76 cases. Palm Beach and Bay County reported eight cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
