




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Seven counties reported a total of 5 animal rabies cases as of January 31, 2016. Raccoons accounted for 4 / 5 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
