Re: Chapter 381.0065(4) (m), F.S. Compliance for "Septic Sav2000"

Dear Mr. Latson:

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of the information concerning the product "**SepticSav2000**" for statewide use in Florida. No product sold in the state for use in onsite sewage treatment and disposal systems may contain any substance in concentrations or amounts that would interfere with or prevent the successful operation of such system, or that would cause discharges from such systems to violate applicable water quality standards, section 381.0065(4) (m), Florida Statutes.

The staff has reviewed the information provided in that SepticSav2000 has the same ingredients, formulation and application rate as the products Digestase SDE 340 and Septic Free which were determined to be in compliance on October 14, 2004. The department has determined that the product, **SepticSav2000**, is also in compliance with s. 381.0065(4) (m), F.S. and has no objection to the use of the product in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. Please be advised that all rules pertaining to the use of the product shall be observed and that there shall be no advertising of the product as state approved.

Be advised that the department is not a testing agency and that this determination reflects only a review of the information submitted by you for compliance with Florida Statutes and Florida Administrative Code. The product evaluation does not investigate the validity of performance claims by manufacturers. For this reason, department acceptance must not be interpreted as certifying effectiveness, endorsing or recommending use of an additive. The Florida Department of Health also does not assume liability for any promise, guarantee or expectation from purchasing or using an additive. The department reserves the right to withdraw acceptance if product formulation or ingredients are modified after product evaluation by the department or subsequently found not to be in compliance with rule.





DIRECTIONS FOR USE: THE DRY BACTERIA CULTURE AND ENZYMES IN THIS FORMULA WORKS BEST IF ACTIVATED BY PREMIXING IN WARM WATER (85 TO 100 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT). DO NOT USE HOT WATER! LET STAND FOR 3 TO 5 MINUTES; POUR SLURRY INTO TOILET AND FLUSH.

USE 1/2 BAG FIRST TWO MONTHS. THEN USE 1/4 BAG PER MONTH
