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Children's Medical Services Managed Care Plan (CMS Plan) is a health plan for children with special health care needs and is offered by the Florida Department of Health.

## **Children's Medical Services Plan Physician Attestation Process for Clinical Eligibility**

The Children's Medical Services Managed Care Plan (CMS Plan) provides children with special health care needs a family-centered, comprehensive, coordinated system of care. The CMS Plan is designed to serve children under age 21 whose serious and chronic physical or developmental conditions require extensive preventive and ongoing care. In January 2016, a new Florida Department of Health rule that governs how children can be determined clinically eligible for the CMS Plan was promulgated. Under [Rule 64C-2.002 of the Florida Administrative Code](#), treating physicians may attest to a current diagnosis and functional limitation qualifying children with chronic and serious conditions as a referral for enrollment into the CMS Plan.

If you are the treating physician of a child and you would like to attest to the eligibility of your patient for the CMS Plan, please review the [CMS Clinical Eligibility Attestation for physicians and a list of qualifying chronic and serious conditions](#). Completed and signed attestations can be submitted by the physician via secure email to [CMS.ClinicalEligibilityScreening@flhealth.gov](mailto:CMS.ClinicalEligibilityScreening@flhealth.gov) or via fax to 850-488-3813. Please be sure to submit all five pages of the attestation.

NOTE: While the attestation form linked above is the version currently in effect, the CMS Plan is continuing the administrative rulemaking process to incorporate proposed changes to the attestation form that include adding certain codes to the form and adding additional options for physicians to utilize a medical review panel to determine clinical eligibility.
