First Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [suffocation \(82\)](#), for 1–4 years old is [drowning \(64\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(17\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(30\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(413\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [poisoning \(654\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [poisoning \(646\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [poisoning \(944\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [poisoning \(496\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [fall \(2,031\)](#).

For all ages the **first ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [poisoning \(3,136\)](#).

Second Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [motor vehicle traffic \(7\)](#), for 1–4 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(15\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [drowning \(5\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [firearm \(14\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [firearm \(388\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [firearm \(419\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [firearm \(330\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(418\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [firearm \(325\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [firearm \(476\)](#).

For all ages the **second ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [motor vehicle traffic \(2,367\)](#).

Third Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [drowning \(4\)](#), for 1–4 years old is [suffocation \(10\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [suffocation \(4\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [suffocation \(12\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [poisoning \(197\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(370\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(322\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [firearm \(405\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(308\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [motor vehicle traffic \(467\)](#).

For all ages the **third ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [firearm \(2,364\)](#).

Fourth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [poisoning \(3\)](#), for 1–4 years old is [struck by, against \(6\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [transport, other \(3\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [drowning \(7\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [suffocation \(95\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [suffocation \(116\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [suffocation \(125\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [suffocation \(198\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [fall \(142\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [suffocation \(262\)](#).

For all ages the **fourth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [fall \(2,356\)](#).

Fifth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [firearm \(2\)](#), for 1–4 years old is [poisoning \(5\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [firearm \(2\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [transport, other \(6\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [drowning \(38\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [cut, pierce \(36\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [drowning \(54\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [fall \(116\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [suffocation \(131\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [poisoning \(186\)](#).

For all ages the **fifth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [suffocation \(1,035\)](#).

Sixth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#), for 1–4 years old is [fall \(3\) \(tied\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [fire, flame \(1\) \(tied\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [poisoning \(5\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [cut, pierce \(22\) \(tied\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [drowning \(35\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [fall \(40\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [drowning \(69\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [drowning \(68\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [drowning \(103\)](#).

For all ages the **sixth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [drowning \(447\)](#).

Seventh Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#), for 1–4 years old is [firearm \(3\) \(tied\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [pedestrian, other \(1\) \(tied\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [fire, flame \(2\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [transport, other \(22\) \(tied\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [fall \(15\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [cut, pierce \(27\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [cut, pierce \(39\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [cut, pierce \(30\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [fire, flame \(44\)](#).

For all ages the **seventh ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [cut, pierce \(169\)](#).

Eighth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#), for 1–4 years old is [fire, flame \(3\) \(tied\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(1\) \(tied\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(1\) \(tied\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [fall \(9\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [transport, other \(14\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [fire, flame \(12\) \(tied\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [fire, flame \(21\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [fire, flame \(19\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [transport, other \(27\)](#).

For all ages the **eighth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [transport, other \(116\)](#).

Ninth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#), for 1–4 years old is [other natural/environment \(2\)](#), for 5–9 years old is [struck by, against \(1\) \(tied\)](#), for 10–14 years old is [struck by, against \(1\) \(tied\)](#), for 15–24 years old is [fire, flame \(4\)](#), for 25–34 years old is [fire, flame \(6\)](#), for 35–44 years old is [transport, other \(12\) \(tied\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [transport, other \(20\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [transport, other \(12\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [other natural/environment \(16\) \(tied\)](#).

For all ages the **ninth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [fire, flame \(112\)](#).

Tenth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#), for 1–4 years old is [two tied](#), for 5–9 years old is [blank](#), for 10–14 years old is [blank](#), for 15–24 years old is [two tied](#), for 25–34 years old is [pedestrian, other \(4\)](#), for 35–44

years old is [pedestrian, other \(7\)](#), for 45–54 years old is [other natural/environment \(11\)](#), for 55–64 years old is [struck by, against \(10\)](#), and for 65 years old and older is [pedestrian, other \(16\) \(tied\)](#).
For all ages the **tenth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [other natural/environment \(44\)](#).
