64D-4.001 Changes

- Section is being eliminated in its entirety
- No rule making authority and the information is basic and not necessary

64D-4.002 Changes

- HIV/AIDS Treatment Extension Act of 2009 (update)
- “Such as parents, adult siblings, adult children, significant others and partners” (delete)
- “Claims the applicant on a health insurance policy. This does not apply to life insurance when the applicant is claimed as the beneficiary” (delete)

64D-4.003 Changes

- More concise definition of requirements for eligibility
- Defines HIV diagnosis as FDA approved test and eliminates specific tests because of constant changes to testing
- Adds language on not being institutionalized
- Updated to newest Application
