






## Incidence & Mortality by Race, Florida, 2012

# Cervical Cancer in Florida, 2012

Since 1992, rate of new cases of cervical cancer has dropped by

**39%**



Since 1992, death rate from cervical cancer has dropped by

**31%**


In 2012, more than half of cervical cancer cases were diagnosed at a late stage

**55%**



In 2012, total charges for all cancer hospitalizations due to cervical cancer was

**\$40,300,000<sup>1</sup>**



The most important risk factor for cervical cancer is infection by the human papilloma virus (HPV). Virtually all cases of cervical cancer are caused by HPV. The two most common types, **16** and **18**, are responsible for about **70 percent** of all cases<sup>2</sup>.

- **The HPV vaccine prevents infection with the most harmful kinds of HPV**
- **Get the HPV vaccine if you are between ages 9 and 26**  
~HPV vaccination can start as early as nine years old for boys and girls with a three dose series through a participating provider
