




# Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Seven counties reported a total of 7 animal rabies cases as of January 31, 2015. Raccoons accounted for 2 / 7 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
