




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Seven counties reported a total of 12 animal rabies cases as of November 30, 2015. Raccoons accounted for 8 / 12 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
