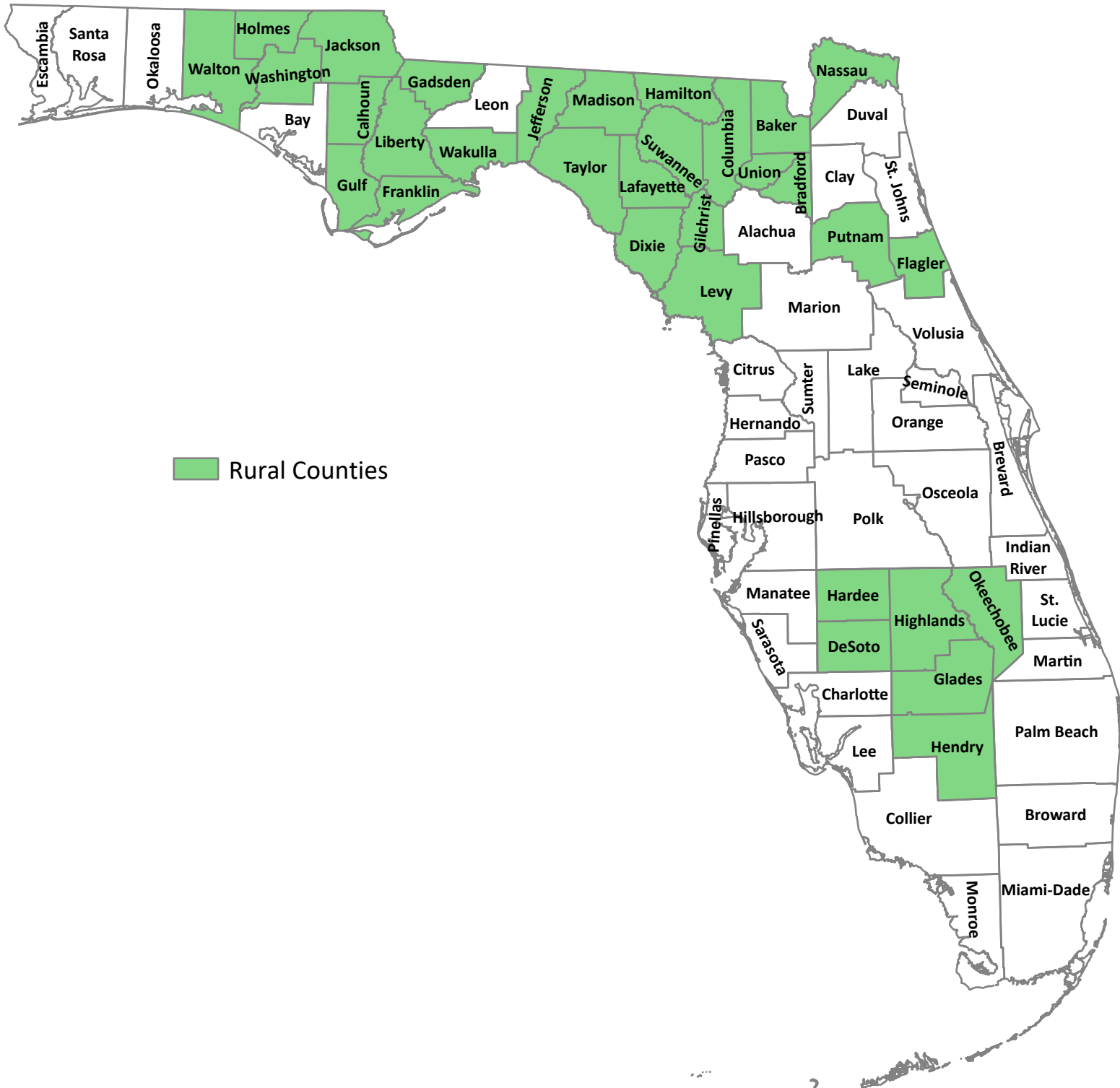


# Florida Rural Counties

Last Update: February 2023



The State of Florida defines rural as:

- A county with a population of 75,000 or less
- A county with a population of 125,000 or less which is contiguous to a county of 75,000 or less
- Any municipality within a county as described above

(Section 288.0656, Florida Statutes)
