**SUBJECT:** Assessment of County Health Department  
Clinic Immunization Coverage Levels (2007)

### INFORMATION ONLY

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In March 2007, the annual county health department (CHD) assessment of immunization coverage levels of one- and two-year-old children receiving services in their facilities was completed. Data provided by the Florida State Health Online Tracking System (SHOTS) contained all active records of children 12 to 23 months of age and children 24 to 35 months of age, with a common review date of January 1, 2007.

The 4 DTaP, 3 Polio, 1 MMR (4/3/1) series has historically been the benchmark in measuring immunization coverage rates of children between 24 and 35 months of age in Florida. Statewide assessment results, as detailed in Attachment 1, indicate that 81% of CHD clients between 24 and 35 months of age completed the 4/3/1 series by their second birthday. To evaluate our progress toward the 90 by '07 goal, the next step is to assess coverage rates based on 4 DTaP, 3 Polio, 1 MMR, 3 Hib, 3 Hep B, and 1 Varicella (4/3/1/3/3/1) series. This year's assessment results, based on the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommendations, revealed that 77% of CHD clients finished the 4 DTaP, 3 Polio, 1 MMR, 3 Hib, 3 Hep B, and 1 Varicella series (4/3/1/3/3/1) by 24 months of age.

CHDs must continue to focus their efforts on children 12 to 23 months of age in order to meet and exceed the 90% coverage goal. The assessment of this cohort of children in the public sector, as portrayed in Attachment 2, shows that 77% completed 3 DTaP, 2 Polio, 2 Hib, and 2 Hepatitis B vaccines by 12 months of age.

The assessment identifies areas where CHDs can focus their efforts to improve coverage levels. Both clinic and countywide results (Attachments 3 and 4) should serve as a critical component of ongoing quality assurance reviews. CHD staff should routinely generate assessment reports via the Florida SHOTS to assess coverage levels and evaluate service delivery. Assessments provide data about vaccine delivery practices and vaccine coverage that both motivate and assist staff in developing and implementing best practices. In addition, Standard 16 of the *Standards for Child and Adolescent Immunization Practices* promotes semi-annual audits to assess immunization coverage levels and a review of immunization records in the provider's patient population.

To consistently exceed the 90% coverage goal among our two-year-old children and in working toward meeting future goals, CHDs must focus their energy and resources in the following key areas:

- Fully implement the CHD Guidebook's immunization internal operating policies and technical assistance guidelines.
- Develop effective strategies for achieving high, sustainable, vaccine coverage levels.
- Assess the impact of intervention and service delivery practices.
- Use all clinic encounters to assess immunization status and provide appropriate immunizations.
