





## Age-Adjusted Diabetes 3-Year Death Rate



Data for 1999 and subsequent years are not fully comparable to data from 1998 and prior years, due to changes in coding of causes of deaths resulting from the switch from the ninth revision of the International Classification of Diseases (ICD9) to the tenth revision (ICD10). The impact of this coding change for 113 selected causes of death is shown in the Vital Statistics Annual Reports.
