The Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) is a state-based telephone surveillance system designed to collect data on individual risk behaviors and preventive health practices of Floridians. Data from the survey are used for health planning, program evaluation, and monitoring health objectives within the Department of Health.
