

From 1998-2015, Current Cigarette Use Has **Decreased**
Middle School: 89%
High School: 75%

From 1998-2015 Current Cigar Use Has **Decreased**
Middle School: 80%
High School: 59%

From 2011-2015 Current E-Cigarette/Vapor Use Has **Increased**
Middle School: 327%
High School: 410%
