SUBJECT: Assessment of County Health Department Immunization

Coverage Levels (2012)

In January 2012, the Bureau of Immunization (BOI) completed an annual immunization assessment for all one- and two-year-old children receiving immunization services in Florida's county health departments (CHDs). Each year, Florida's 67 CHDs administer thousands of doses to children whose parents rely on the CHD as their child's immunization provider. This assessment and the results reported here are related to children with a CHD immunization home. The assessment results identify areas where additional focus can improve immunization coverage for this targeted population, thereby meeting the 90% national and state coverage goal.

The Florida State Health Online Tracking System (SHOTS) provided the data for this assessment, which consists of all active records of children 12 to 23 months of age and children 24 to 35 months of age, respectively, with a common review date of January 1, 2012. The results are based on recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP), which recommends the following:

- All children between 24 and 35 months of age complete the 4:3:1:3:3:1
 (4 DTaP/DTP/DT, 3 Polio, 1 MMR, 3 Hib, 3 Hep B, and 1 Varicella) immunization series by 24 months of age.
- All children between 12 and 23 months of age complete the 3:2:2:2
 (3 DTaP/DTP/DT, 2 Polio, 2 Hib, and 2 Hep B) immunization series by 12 months of age.

Enclosure 1 shows that statewide, 95% of two-year-old children completed the 4:3:1:3:3:1 series by 24 months of age, a 1% increase from last year. Forty-one of the 67 CHDs achieved or exceeded the national and state goal, ten of these attaining 100%.

Coverage level data for the 4:3:1:3:3:1:4 series (4:3:1:3:3:1 plus four doses of pneumococcal conjugate (PCV)) is also provided. These results show that statewide, 93% of two-year-old children assessed completed this series by 24 months of age.

Enclosure 2 shows that statewide, 88% of one-year-old children completed the 3:2:2:2 series by 12 months of age. Twenty-five of the 67 CHDs achieved or exceeded the national and state goal, including three, which achieved 100%.

Children who miss the fourth dose of DTaP/DTP/DT negatively impact statewide efforts to achieve the 90% coverage goal. The reminder and recall tool, which identifies those active children due for immunization, is important to use in improving coverage levels.

To consistently achieve the coverage goal of our one- and two-year-old children, it is important for CHDs to focus their efforts and resources in the following key areas:

- Fully implement the CHD Guidebook's immunization technical assistance guidelines (TAG) and policies (DOHP).
- Develop effective strategies for achieving high, sustainable vaccine coverage levels.
- Assess the impact of intervention on service delivery practices.
- Use all clinic encounters to assess immunization status and provide appropriate immunizations.

We encourage you to contact your local Bureau of Immunization field staff to assist with identifying areas of need and developing strategies for increasing your immunization rates. Collaborative efforts will help us sustain gains achieved in protecting Florida's two-year-old children and enable us to achieve our common goal of providing Florida's infant population with the best protection possible against vaccine-preventable diseases.
