

Hepatitis A Surveillance January 1, 2018–January 2, 2021


Counties that reported hepatitis A cases in the past two weeks are outlined in black. Since January 1, 2018, 98% of cases have likely been acquired locally in Florida.



The graph below represents hepatitis A cases by week from December 29, 2019 to January 2, 2021. There were 25 hepatitis A cases reported in the past two weeks.








Hepatitis A Vaccination Surveillance January 1, 2019–January 2, 2021



In 2019 CHDs have administered 164,596 vaccinations and non-CHDs have administered 228,538 vaccinations for a total of 393,134 vaccinations. Vaccinations given before the public health emergency declaration are shown in lighter colors than those given after. Since declaration of the PHE, CHDs have administered 98,969 and non-CHDs have administered 135,990 vaccinations.
