This letter is to acknowledge receipt of the information concerning the products "**Roebic K-37, Roebic K-47, Roebic K-57, Roebic K-87, and Roebic Grease Destroyer**" for statewide use in Florida. No product sold in the state for use in onsite sewage treatment and disposal systems may contain any substance in concentrations or amounts that would interfere with or prevent the successful operation of such system, or that would cause discharges from such systems to violate applicable water quality standards, section 381.0065(4)(m), Florida Statutes.

The staff has reviewed the information provided in the MSDS, 96-hr LC<sub>50</sub> toxicity test results, and laboratory results on volatile organic compounds for the product. The department has determined that the following products are in compliance with s. 381.0065(4)(m), F.S. and has no objection to the use of the product in accordance with manufacturer's specifications:



# GREASE DESTROYER

**Roebic Grease Destroyer** is a concentrated combination of non-pathogenic bacteria, grease cutting surfactant and a pleasant odor neutralizing fragrance. **Grease Destroyer** is recommended for any plumbing or grease trap and wastewater system with high levels of fats, oils and grease. Use **Grease Destroyer** to remove caked on grease and fats from barbeque grills, drip pans and utensils, kitchen hoods and grease spills on patio or deck.

### DIRECTIONS

**SEPTIC TANK and CESSPOOLS:** Apply one quart per 1000 gallons monthly to degrade and prevent fats and grease build-up.

**GREASE TRAPS and INTERCEPTORS:** Initial treatment – apply one quart per 500 gallons. Maintenance – apply 4-8 oz. weekly to maintain system and prevent build-up.

**PIPES and PLUMBING SYSTEMS:** Pour 6-8 oz. down sink, floor drain or clean-out twice weekly until water flow improves, then add 8 ounces weekly to maintain clean, open lines.

**HARD SURFACES:** Soak grill or utensils for 20-30 minutes, rinse and wash with soap and water. To remove grease spills and stains from patios and decks, soak for at least 30 minutes, brush and then hose off.
