Radon is a colorless, odorless, tasteless, radioactive gas that causes lung cancer. 1 in 5 homes in Florida are considered at high risk, this contest aims to provide an opportunity for educating Florida youth and the public.

Your video must not exceed 60 seconds, and the topics are: (choose one)

- What is radon?
- Where does radon come from?
- How does radon get into our homes?
- Radon can cause lung cancer.
- Test your home for radon

Judges are looking for a video that has accurate content on radon (do your research), communicates the topic visually, is easily reproduced and original.
