Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer overall and is the leading cause among non-smokers. It's a radioactive carcinogen that's colorless, odorless and tasteless. In Florida, one in five homes tested has elevated radon levels above the limits set by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Elevated radon levels have been found in all types of Florida buildings: homes, schools, offices and high-rise condominiums.

Radon comes from the radioactive breakdown of naturally occurring radium found in most Florida soils, rocks and groundwater. As a gas, it becomes trapped and concentrated after entering a building through small openings in the foundation or from building materials.

If the test determines that you have high concentrations of radon gas in your home, the problem can be fixed by installing a proper mitigation system in your home which costs about the same as any other common repair.
