## STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH DECLARATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2016, a Public Health Emergency was declared by the Surgeon General for the following counties: Miami-Dade, Hillsborough, Lee and Santa Rosa due to confirmed travel-related cases of the Zika virus in those counties.

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2016 the Surgeon General expanded the Public Health Emergency to include Broward County; and

WHEREAS, there have been additional confirmed travel-related cases of the Zika virus (none of which have been pregnant women) in both Osceola County and Saint Johns County.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, John H. Armstrong, MD, FACS, Surgeon General of Florida and State Health Officer, by virtue of Executive Order Number 16-29 of Governor Rick Scott and the authority vested in me by section 381.00315, Florida Statutes, do hereby declare the following:

- 1. Section 1. A Public Health Emergency is declared in Osceola County and Saint Johns County.
- 2. Section 2. Osceola County and Saint Johns County shall comply with the directives set forth in Sections 3 and 4 of the Public Health Emergency Declaration issued on February 3, 2016.
