The Department of Health (Department) management requested the Office of Inspector General (OIG) to review the accuracy of any statements made and data included in grant applications submitted by the Department of Health in Charlotte County (DOH-Charlotte) during the period August, 2016 through March, 2018.

What we found

We selected three grant applications to review. No issues were identified.

Grantor	Original Requested Amount	Summary
Southwest Florida Community Foundation	\$50,000	The grant application was submitted electronically, with appropriate narrative. The grant was not awarded.
Closing the Gap Grant	\$100,000	A budget amount was prepared. However, the grant application was not submitted.
Ryan White Part B	\$208,025	DOH-Charlotte was allocated \$97,595 by the Department's Bureau of Communicable Disease, HIV/AIDS Section (HIV/AIDS Section). DOH-Charlotte's management subsequently decided not to initiate the proposed project. The HIV/AIDS Section reallocated \$75,000 to DOH-Leon. \$22,595 remained at DOH-DeSoto as the Area 8 Ryan White Lead Agency for reallocation.
