## **How Comprehensive EHE Proposals Will Be Scored**

Each proposal will be evaluated and scored based on the category requirements identified in **Section F**. Applications will be scored by objective Review Teams using evaluation sheets to designate the point value assigned to each application. The scores of each member of the Review Teams will be averaged with the scores of the other members to determine the final score. Application scores establish a reference point from which to make negotiation decisions. The maximum points possible are **100**. Scoring will be in the following categories, up to the maximum points indicated for each category:
