COMMENTS

Florida Department of Health follows Florida Department of Education practice and used 10/15/2010 (third Friday in October, which is fall public school FTE count) for it's Child Count date.

Florida did not include 1047 children in the count who are no longer being served under an active IFSP. These children's families were sent prior written notice and moved to inactive status after multiple unsuccessful attempts to contact the family, in accordance with OSEP-approved state policy. According to the instructions for Table 3 completion, these children should be considered exited from the program. Lead Agency staff consulted with representatives from DAC (Carol Bruce, Sharon Walsh and Luis Romero) and Florida's OSEP State Contact (Hillary Tabor) in the preparation of this table.

Florida narrowed the eligibility criteria for participation in Part C effective 7/1/10, after the mandatory public participation process and OSEP approval.

Florida is updating our FFY 1011 submission to include the Section D optional cumulative count. We will update our FFY 1112 submission once the data is available after the fiscal year ends for FFY 1112.
