SKI-HI is a resource curriculum for use with families with children ages 0-5 who are deaf or hard of hearing.

VIISA is a resource curriculum for use with families with children ages 0-5 who are blind or visually impaired.

INSITE is a resource curriculum for use with families with children ages 0-5 who are deaf/hard of hearing and/or blind/visually impaired with additional disabilities.

SKI-HI, INSITE, VIISA, are curricula that were developed under Office of Special Education Programs grants to the SKI-HI Institute at Utah State University. They are recognized and used in more than two-thirds of the United States as statewide early intervention models. From their inception, they were designed to be implemented in partnership with families, providing them with the most current information and support relative to their child with special needs. Florida has certified state trainers in all four models. The Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind Parent Infant Outreach Program is the lead agency.
