- I. Office of Trauma
 - Updates & Discussions-
 - A copy of the annual report was mailed out in January to all trauma centers and is on the Office of Trauma's website.

- II. Office of Injury Prevention updates- Lisa VanderWerf-Hourigan
 - Updates & Discussions-
 - Booster seat bill is still in committee
 - Hyperthermia-National Safety Kids is launching a campaign this year in Florida and needs to locate a source to obtain data on hyperthermia in kids. Consensus was hyperthermia is something not normally put in the trauma registry unless and a traumatic event was experienced.

- III. Registry Updates:
 - Status on Complication list & hospital discharge date-
 - NTDS complication list was agreed upon and the Office of Trauma is awaiting the official request to be submitted from AFTC/COT.
 - Hospital discharge date clarification- AFTC committee had made a request for all trauma centers to submit their hospital's policy regarding hospital dc date for review/collaboration and this is still ongoing.
 - DOA final definition request- Office of Trauma still waiting on official request
 - Definition was agreed upon and Dr. Gill is to send in an official request to the Office of Trauma.
 - Update status on the 2010 data load into the data warehouse
 - The registry staff is working with vendors and trauma centers to fix issues that are impeding the data load of three facilities. We are also, looking at data quality and preparing compliance reports that will be sent out to each trauma center over the next few months.
 - *BSCIP Referral status- Pending still-*
 - *Office of Trauma and Brian and Spinal Cord Injury Program are meeting to discuss and will have a resolution by the next conference call.*

- NGTR project update- Brittney Aucutt

 - Digital Innovations was awarded the state contract for the new trauma registry for the State and we will begin to work with them in the very near future.
 - Susan reiterated that we are doing business as usual and moving forward to streamline the registry.

 - All complications review vs. case criteria only- most are reviewing complications only if they meet the criteria for case review.
