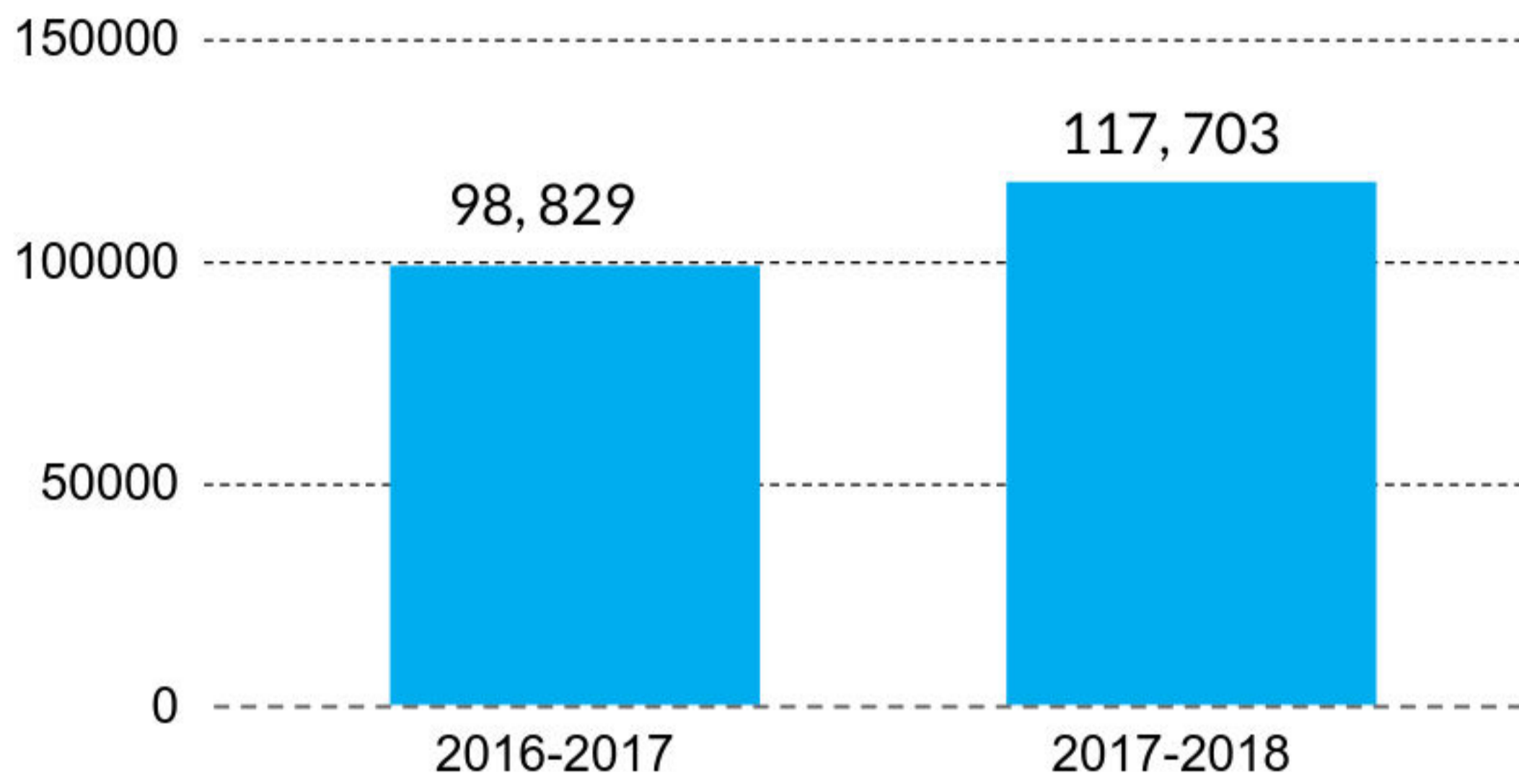

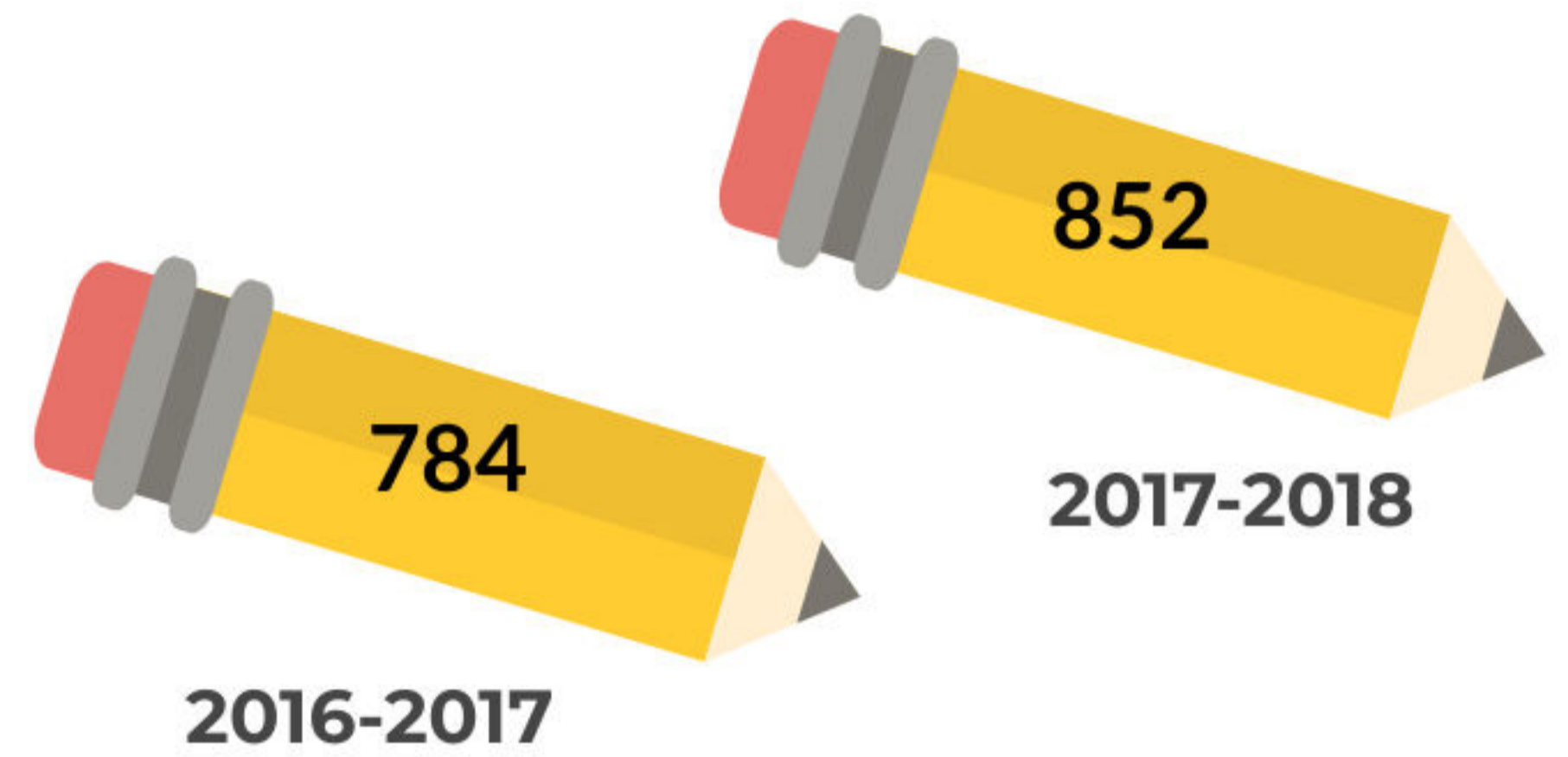


School-Based Sealant Programs (S-BSPs) are cost effective, evidence-based interventions to provide preventive dental services to students at the school site.

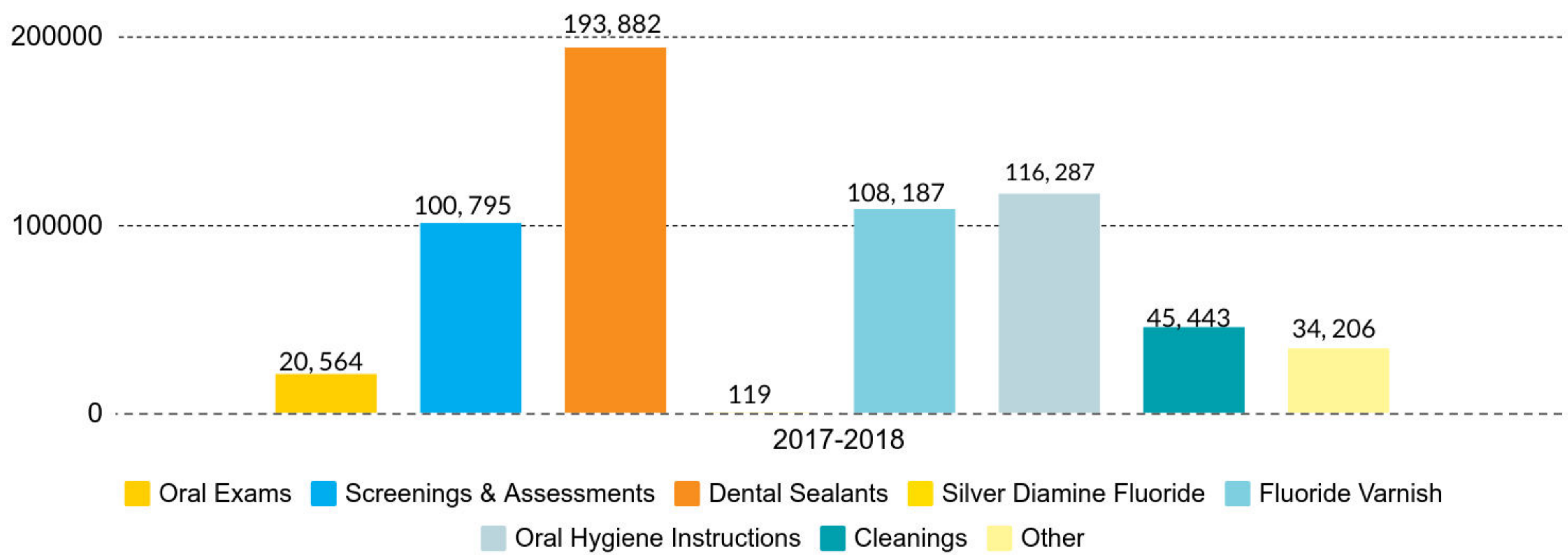
Total Number of Children Served by S-BSPs



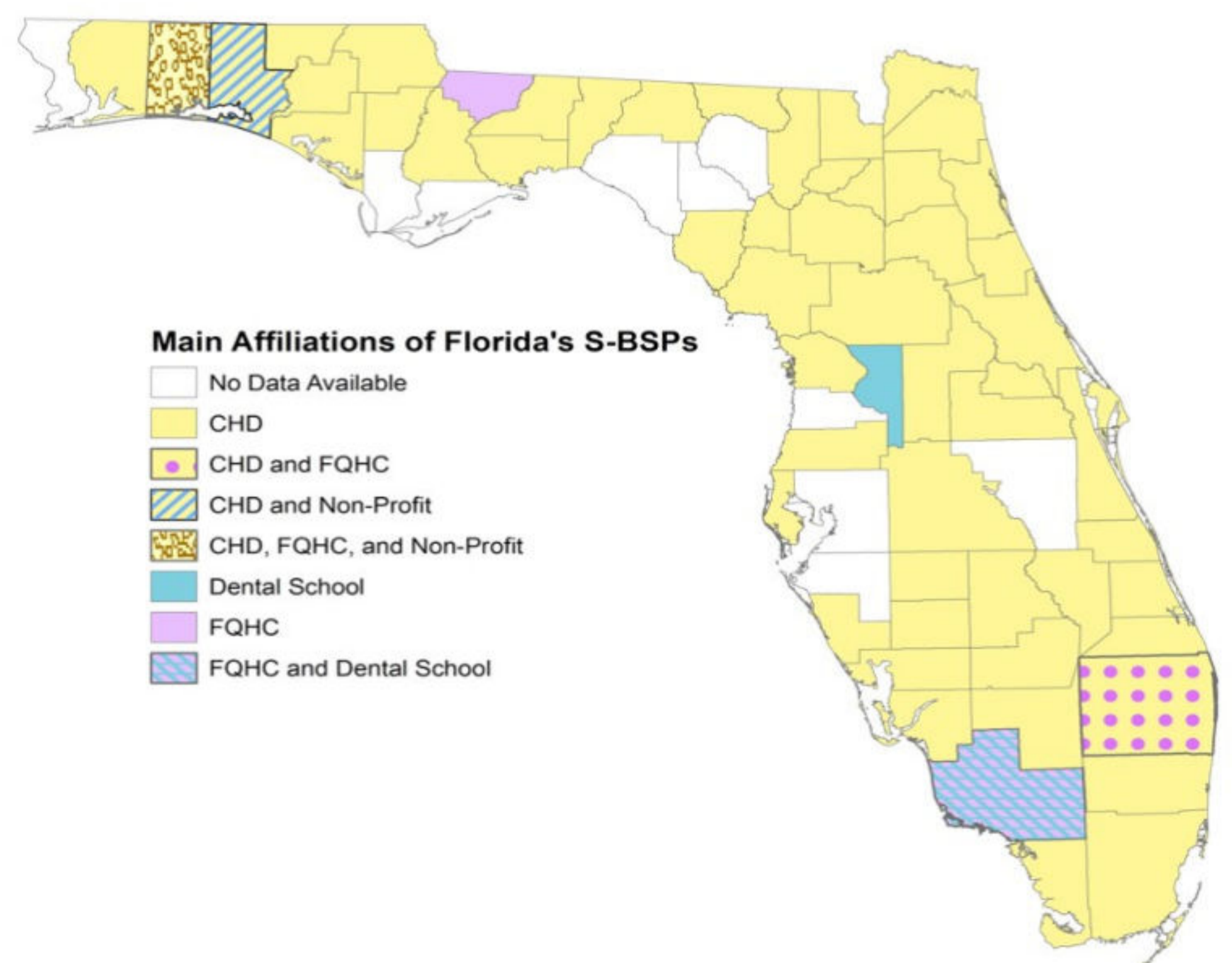
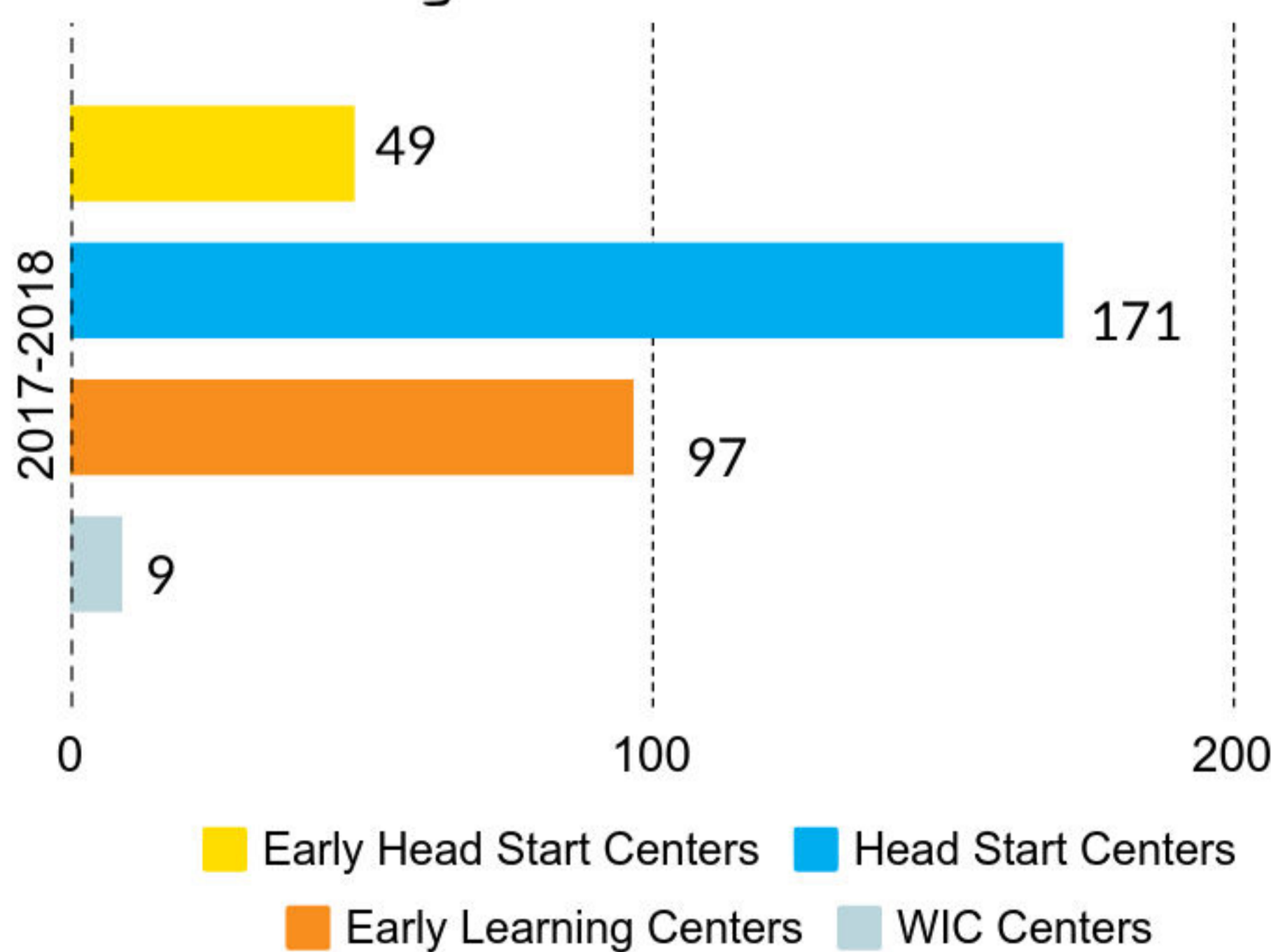
Total Number of Schools Visited Through S-BSPs

S-BSPs programs reach students attending Title I schools, which are schools with a high percentage of children eligible for the free or reduced lunch program. S-BSPs are in over 900 schools, Head Start Centers, Early Head Start Centers, Early Learning Centers, and Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Centers throughout Florida.
