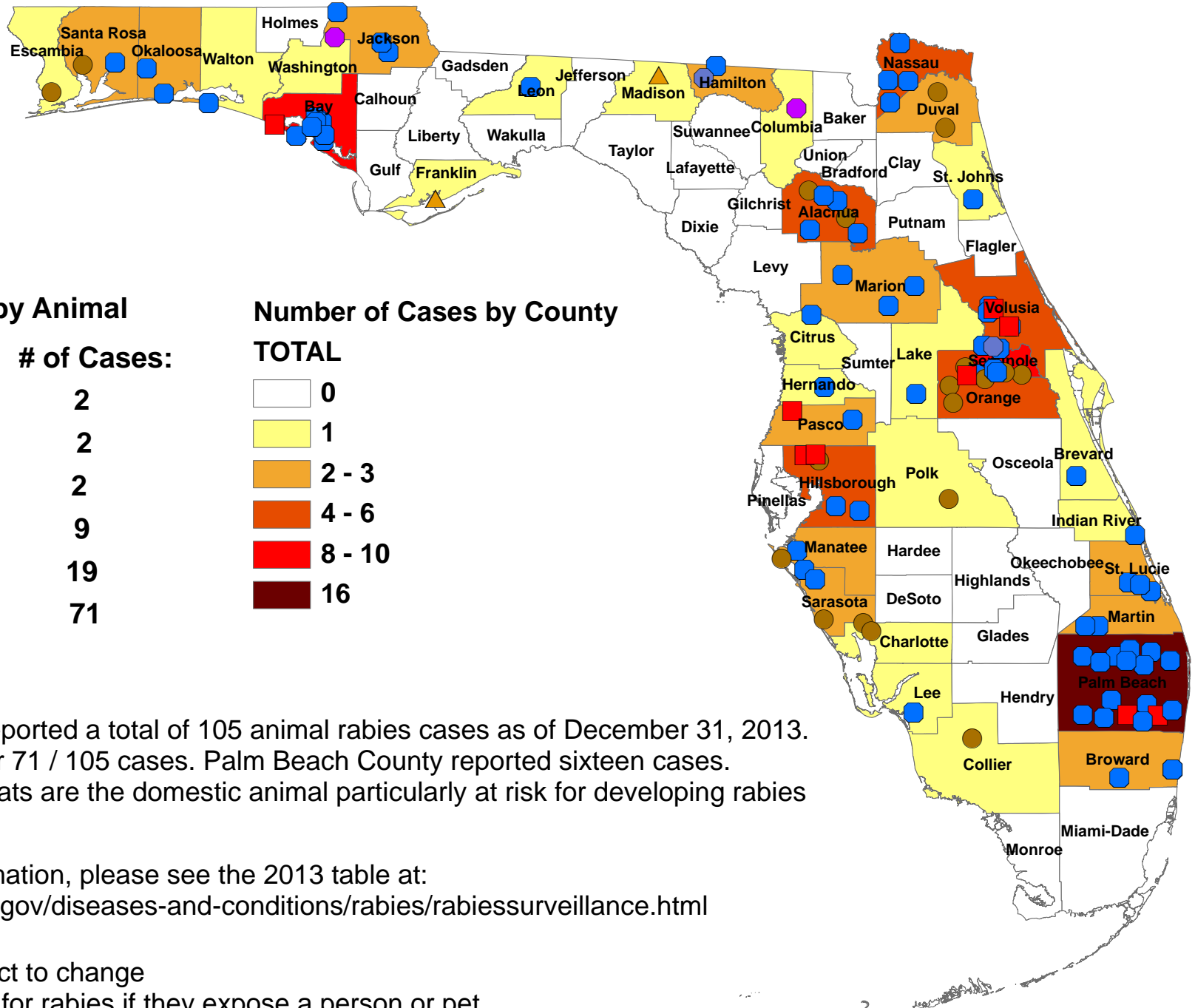




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Thirty-seven counties reported a total of 105 animal rabies cases as of December 31, 2013. Raccoons accounted for 71 / 105 cases. Palm Beach County reported sixteen cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
