Marketplace Open Enrollment Starts November 1, 2015

Attention client with a Marketplace Insurance plan.

Important information about re-enrolling in your Marketplace plan for 2016.

The ADAP program will release more information before the start of open enrollment outlining the steps that you will need to take in order to enroll in a supported plan for 2016.

According to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, all individuals enrolled in a health insurance plan through the Federally-Facilitated Marketplace for 2015 will be automatically re-enrolled into their plan for the 2016 benefit year.

IMPORTANT: Do not automatically re-enroll into the insurance plan you currently have. Some 2016 Marketplace plans may no longer be available and others may have changes to their premium or benefit structure and no longer qualify as an approved plan.

- A list of Marketplace insurance plans that will be supported for the 2016 benefit year will be provided by the ADAP program.
- Your current insurance premium will be paid until new insurance coverage is activated.

As a Marketplace client, you will need to select a pre-approved plan during the upcoming Marketplace open enrollment period before December 15th, 2015 to prevent auto-enrollment.

(Open enrollment period is November 1, 2015 to January 31, 2016)

The ADAP program currently pays for your Marketplace plan and will continue to provide Marketplace plan assistance for eligible clients who enroll in a designated, supported plan for 2016. Premium tax credits contribute to the premium costs of health insurance plans purchased through the Marketplace for eligible individuals. An individual's eligibility for premium tax credits may change from year to year and as such, eligibility will be re-evaluated.
