

Q. What is the Florida AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)?

A. ADAP is a medication program that provides access to HIV/AIDS drugs to eligible persons who are uninsured or underinsured.

Q. How does ADAP provide clients with HIV/AIDS medications?

- A. ADAP provides HIV/AIDS medications in one of three ways:
- ⇒ Providing medications to you directly through the local county health department.
 - ⇒ By purchasing insurance plans that cover HIV/AIDS medications that are on the Florida ADAP formulary*, or
 - ⇒ By helping you with premiums, copays and/or deductibles for your approved insurance plan.

Q. Why would ADAP purchase insurance plans for eligible clients?

- A. When ADAP purchases insurance for you, ensuring your medication needs are met is the main priority of ADAP.
- ⇒ ADAP will only purchase insurance plans that cover ADAP formulary* medications.
 - ⇒ ADAP will only cover plans that are approved by the State ADAP program office.
