



## Adults (Age 13+) who received an HIV diagnosis by ZIP code of residence, 2016–2018, Broward County





## The highest proportion of persons who received an HIV diagnosis in Broward County in 2018 were age 20–29




## Blacks represented the highest proportion of persons who received an HIV diagnosis in Broward County in 2018

## Males in Broward County were more likely to receive an HIV diagnosis than females in 2018




## HIV Diagnosis Rates by Year of Diagnosis, 2009–2018, Broward County (30% Decrease)



**HIV Diagnoses in Broward County.** Broward County observed a 24 percent decrease in HIV diagnoses from 2009 (867 diagnoses) to 2018 (661 diagnoses).

**Broward County 2018 HIV Care Continuum** The HIV care continuum reflects the series of steps a person living with an HIV diagnosis (PLWH) takes from initial diagnosis to being retained in care and achieving a very low level of HIV in the body (viral suppression). PLWH with a suppressed viral load (<200 copies/mL) are highly unlikely to transmit the virus to others.



**In Care:** Documented care  $\geq 1$  time in 2018. **Retained in Care:** Documented care  $\geq 2$  times,  $\geq 3$  months apart in 2018.
