



# Surveillance Case Definition for AIDS in Florida

**AIDS Cases became reportable in Florida in 1981.**

**A person with a positive confirmatory HIV antibody test or positive virologic test (qualitative or quantitative) and**

**🚫 In Adult/Adolescent Case Only (13 years of age or older):**


- Has a CD4 absolute count below 200, or
- Has a CD4 of less than 14 percent total lymphocytes

**🚫 In Adult/Adolescent and Pediatric Cases:**

- Has been diagnosed with one or more AIDS-defining illness (Opportunistic Infection)



# *Progression of Diagnosed AIDS Cases\* Florida, 1981 - 2013*







# Diagnosed AIDS Cases\* Florida, through 1986




Each dot = 3 cases

# Diagnosed AIDS Cases\* Florida, through 1991





# Diagnosed AIDS Cases\* Florida, through 1996





# Diagnosed AIDS Cases Florida, through 2000





Each dot = 3 cases



Each dot = 3 cases


