



Total Adult HIV Infection Cases By Sex, Reported in 2014








Total Adult AIDS Cases By Sex, Reported in 2014





Total Adult HIV Infection Cases By Race/Ethnicity, Reported in 2014




Total Adult AIDS Cases By Race/Ethnicity, Reported in 2014

Total Adult HIV Infection Cases By Age Group of Diagnosis, Reported in 2014



Total Adult AIDS Cases By Age Group of Diagnosis, Reported in 2014






Total Adult Male HIV Infection Cases By Mode of Exposure, Reported in 2014





Total Adult Male AIDS Cases By Mode of Exposure, Reported in 2014





Total Adult Female HIV Infection Cases By Mode of Exposure, Reported in 2014






Total Adult Female AIDS Cases By Mode of Exposure, Reported in 2014




