The Hepatitis B Virus (HBV) is a very contagious & serious disease.

- **It attacks the liver**
- **It can be easily spread to others**

A small amount of blood can be enough to pass the virus.

HBV is spread by blood & body fluids

- Unprotected anal, vaginal or oral sex
- Sharing injection drug equipment
- Sharing tattoo needles
- Pregnant woman to her baby
- Sharing toothbrushes, razors or other personal items
- Household contacts
- Accidental needle stick
