




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Thirty-six counties reported a total of 93 animal rabies cases as of November 30, 2013. Raccoons accounted for 62 / 93 cases. Palm Beach County reported thirteen cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
