




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Thirty-three counties reported a total of 91 animal rabies cases as of December 31, 2014. Raccoons accounted for 49 / 91 cases. Palm Beach County reported nine cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
