




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

January 1, 2014 - March 31, 2014



Thirteen counties reported a total of 21 animal rabies cases as of March 31, 2014. Raccoons accounted for 14 / 21 cases. Bay, Hillsborough and Palm Beach Counties reported three cases each. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
