




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

January 1, 2014 - May 31, 2014



Twenty counties reported a total of 41 animal rabies cases as of May 31, 2014. Raccoons accounted for 28 / 41 cases. Palm Beach County reported seven cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
