




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Thirty-two counties reported a total of 79 animal rabies cases as of November 30, 2014. Raccoons accounted for 43 / 79 cases. Palm Beach and Bay County reported eight cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
