




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Nine counties reported a total of 12 animal rabies cases as of February 28, 2015. Raccoons accounted for 7 / 12 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
