




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Twenty-three counties reported a total of 40 animal rabies cases as of July 31, 2015. Raccoons accounted for 19 / 40 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
