




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Fourteen counties reported a total of 20 animal rabies cases as of March 31, 2015. Raccoons accounted for 12 / 20 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
