




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Six counties reported a total of 7 animal rabies cases as of February 29, 2016. Raccoons accounted for 4 / 7 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
