




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Twenty-seven counties reported a total of 52 animal rabies cases as of October 31, 2016. Raccoons accounted for 27 / 52 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
