




# Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Twenty-six counties reported a total of 44 animal rabies cases as of September 30, 2016. Raccoons accounted for 24 / 44 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
