

## BEST PRACTICES FOR FARM CREW LEADERS AGAINST COVID-19



### Clean & disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily:

- Busses and Employee Transport Vehicles
  - Seat backs and seatbelts
  - Handrails and arm rests
  - Any additional commonly touched items
- Eating Areas
  - Tables
  - Chairs and benches
- Field Toilets
  - Interior and exterior toilet-house door handles
  - Hand wash sink faucets/spigots
  - Soap dispenser



### Cleaners, Disinfectants, and PPE:

- Cleaning solution – ¼ ounce liquid detergent per 1 gallon of water
- \*Disinfectant – 5 tablespoons (1/3 cup) bleach per 1 gallon of water
- Wear gloves and face coverings when cleaning and disinfecting

### Recommendations:

- Busses and employee transport vehicles
  - Increase ventilation by opening windows or adjusting A/C
  - Stagger seating to limit capacity, allowing for social distancing
  - Have occupants wear face coverings
  - Place hand sanitizer at entrances
- General
  - Hang hand wash signs at all hand wash sinks/stations, including near field toilets
  - Sick employees should follow CDC-recommended steps\*\*
