## INFORMATION ONLY

NSF International has certified the following aerobic treatment units (ATU) by Fuji Clean USA, LLC as meeting all of the requirements of ANSI/NSF Standard 40 - Residential Wastewater Treatment Systems for Class I classification:

- Models CE5, CE7, CE10 based on Wastewater Technology Evaluation Report 13/14/055/0030 and
- Models CEN5, CEN7, CEN10 based on Wastewater Technology Evaluation Report 13/15/055/0030.

Fuji Clean USA has received treatment receptacle approval for several tanks that will house the aerobic treatment units as shown in the attachment.

Please note that these aerobic treatment units will be added to the listing of ATUs acceptable for use in the State of Florida.
