
This letter is to acknowledge receipt of additional information on March 13, 2002 concerning the product "**Nature's Best Liquid-Live**" for statewide use in Florida. No product sold in the state for use in onsite sewage treatment and disposal systems may contain any substance in concentrations or amounts that would interfere with or prevent the successful operation of such system, or that would cause discharges from such systems to violate applicable water quality standards, section 381.0065(4)(m), Florida Statutes.

The staff has reviewed the information provided in the MSDS, 96-hr LC₅₀ toxicity test results, and laboratory results on volatile organic compounds for the product. The staff also re-evaluated the toxicity results based on the revised recommended application rate of no more than 4 ounces of the product. The department has determined the product, **Nature's Best Liquid-Live**, to be in compliance with s. 381.0065(4)(m), F.S. and has no objection to the use of the product in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. Please be advised that all rules pertaining to the use of the products shall be observed and that there shall be no advertising of the products as state approved.

Be advised that the department is not a testing agency and that this determination reflects only a review of the information submitted by you for compliance with Florida Statutes and Florida Administrative Code. The product evaluation does not investigate the validity of performance claims by manufacturers. For this reason, departmental acceptance must not be interpreted as certifying effectiveness, endorsing or recommending use of an additive. The Florida Department of Health also does not assume liability for any promise, guarantee or expectation from purchasing or using an additive. The department reserves the right to withdraw acceptance if product formulation or ingredients are modified after product evaluation by the department or subsequently found not to be in compliance with rule.

This letter of product compliance is limited to Department of Health jurisdictional circumstances as defined in Chapter 64E-6, Florida Administrative Code and Chapter 381.0065, Florida Statutes. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Odor Control: To eliminate odors caused by vomit, spoiled foods, decomposed animals, animal waste, in areas such as garbage cans, waste receptacles, locker rooms, carpet, etc. Spray product directly on malodor and allow the bacterial action to ingest the material while the pleasant fragrance immediately neutralizes the odor.

Carpet Deodorizing & Digesting Organic Waste:

1) Spot clean and vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix 1/2 to 1 pint of product per gallon of water. Apply with pump or hand sprayer. Keep moist at least 30 minutes. Repeat if odor persists.

2) Use in conjunction with carpet cleaning equipment. Use 1/2 to 1 pint product to every gallon of mixed cleaner. Use with all types of carpet cleaning equipment and methods, including tank, brush, bonnet and extraction cleaning.

Septic Tanks: Add 4 1/2 ounces per day for 30 days, thereafter add 32 ounces a month.

RV's / Boats: Add 2 ounces per gallon of water in holding tank. Thereafter, use 1 ounce per added gallon of waste water.

Grease Traps: For grease traps of 2000 gallons – for initial treatment add 1 gallon directly to trap or through a drain, then add 20 ounces per day. For best results, traps should be treated daily, at time of lowest flow. Use of a timed metering pump will ensure proper dosage and maximum performance.

Drains: Add directly to troublesome drains at a rate of 3 to 4 ounces per day till running free. As a preventative maintenance program add to all drains at a rate of 3 to 4 ounces per week at the time of least activity (closing time is best).
