SUBJECT: B-HS1 Homeowner acceptance

Hazen and Sawyer established an agreement with [REDACTED] dated October 4, 2010 for permitting, construction, modifications, operation, maintenance, monitoring, and inspections of an innovative nitrogen reduction system as part of the Florida Onsite Sewage Nitrogen Reduction Strategies (FOSNRS) Study under contract CORCL with the Florida Department of Health. The study period on this system has ended. The homeowner has indicated that he will not agree to take ownership of the innovative system and would like it removed. However, the homeowner will agree to extend the homeowner agreement to another study period for a simpler second experimental system with less energy use as outlined in the attached acceptance of system ownership and responsibility form signed by the homeowner.

Therefore, we are in the process of developing design documents and completing the permit application for a second experimental system at [REDACTED] Crawfordville, FL.

In June, 2011 an innovative onsite wastewater treatment system was installed at [REDACTED] Crawfordville, Florida 32327 as part of the Florida Department of Health Onsite Sewage Nitrogen Reduction Strategies Study. As outlined in the agreement between Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. and Patrick Suderman dated October 4, 2010, Hazen and Sawyer has to date been responsible for permitting, construction, modifications, operation, maintenance, monitoring, and inspections of this innovative nitrogen reduction system over an 18 month study period. This study period has now ended. As indicated in the agreement, Hazen and Sawyer is responsible for removal or leaving the experimental system in place at study termination. The homeowner indicated in January 2013, that he will not agree to take ownership of the innovative system and would like it removed. However, the homeowner will agree to extend the homeowner agreement to another study period for a simpler experimental system with less energy use.

I hereby release Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. from any and all responsibility or liability for the performance or non-performance of this system after the date this acceptance of system agreement is signed by both parties below.
